Some of us will explore the iconic village of Zermatt, where we can marvel at the Matterhorn, the towering peak that rises to 4'478 meters. Zermatt is one of the few car-free towns in Switzerland, ensuring breathtakingly clear views of the Matterhorn, which is famously known as the inspiration for the Toblerone chocolate shape.

Others will head to Saas-Fee, known as the "Pearl of the Alps," where we have the chance to encounter the region's charming groundhogs, also known as marmots.

Groundhogs hibernate for 6 to 8 months in winter, but right now they are well awake - how many can you spot?

Another off-site activity foresees a visit the World Nature Forum and take in the awe-inspiring Aletsch Glacier, the largest in the Alps, stretching over 23 kilometers.





Swiss fact: **C. 1st August**

Swiss National Day, celebrated on August 1st, commemorates the founding of the Swiss Confederation in 1291. This day marks the signing of the Federal Charter, an alliance between the cantons of Uri, Schwyz, and Unterwalden, which laid the foundation for the Switzerland we know today.
