



Merci vilmal - This phrase means "Thank you very much." It combines the French word "merci" (thank you) with the Swiss German "vilmal" (very much).


**Zvieri -** A Swiss German term for an afternoon snack, typically eaten around 4 PM. It can include bread, cheese, fruit, or pastries.
