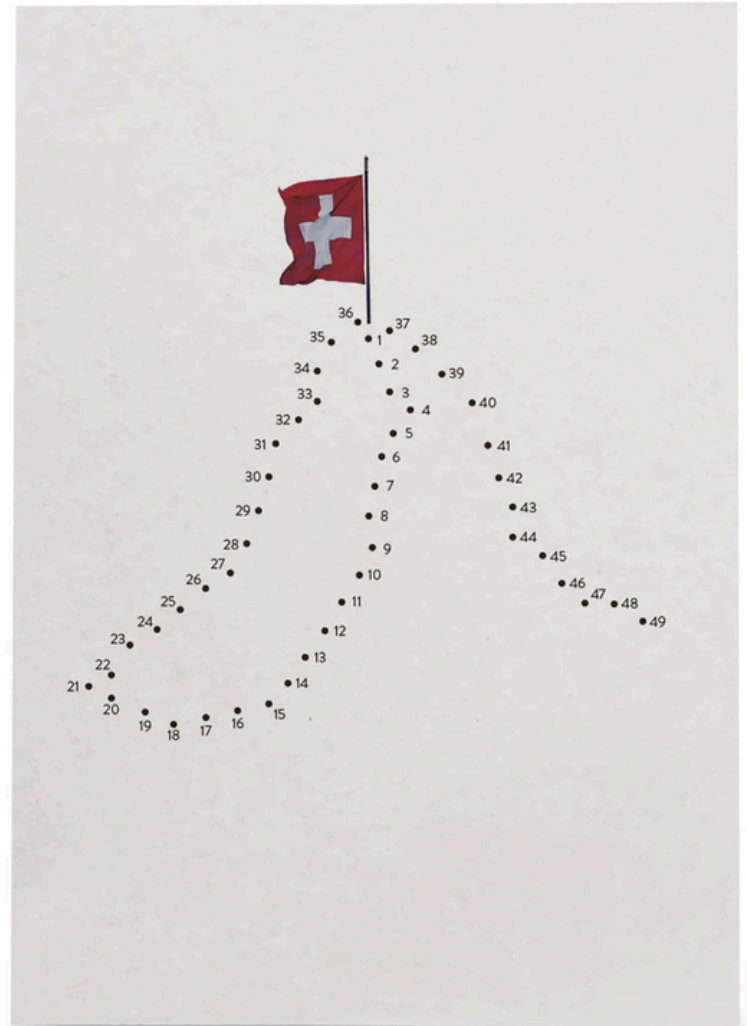

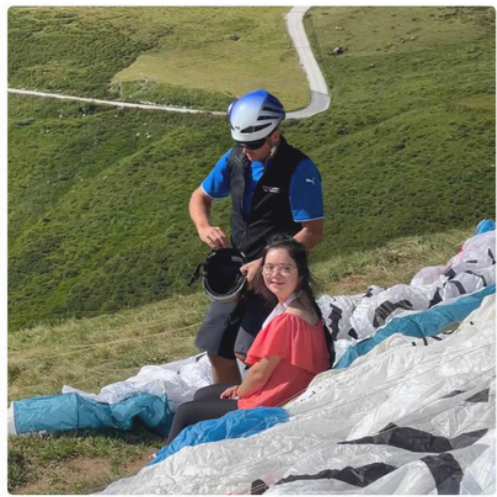


RÜEBLI: THAT'S HOW CARROTS ARE CALLED IN SWISS GERMAN
